


The Ian Proctor designed Pirate has proved itself over the past four years to be an ideal family craft to start keelboat sailing. Ryplas Distributors have undertaken to provide the boat in a form similar to their successful Express Dinghy; that is, suitable for the handyman to assemble at home. The hull and deck, with its self draining cockpit, will be supplied moulded and joined to the specification laid down by Rydgeway Marine, who will continue to produce the professionally built boat. The interior is designed to utilise marine plywood, and the boards are pre-marked for ease of cutting. All glue and wood screws are provided, together with rudder blade and other hardwood components. Deck fittings, with their fastenings, are carefully packed for simple identification. Running and standing rigging, spars, and sails are included. A new form of ballast is provided for the twin bilge keels which can be added at the final stage, so allowing for the easy handling of the shell during the initial stages of building. Plenty of simple to follow diagrams in the Building Manual enables rapid and workmanlike completion of the project, giving you the satisfaction of building and






